A BRIEF THOUGHT

Isaiah 43:14-25

"All of Scripture points to the forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ. "All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name" (Acts 10:43). God is never silent. He always speaks to you with words of invitation. God does not forgive you based on the quality of your confession or your resolve to be a better person. But you keep think-ing otherwise. Your standard is what you would do to someone like yourself, and chances are that you would not let the incident pass quickly. God, however, forgives for his own name's sake. "I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more" (Isaiah 43:25). There may be no finer words in Scripture. God bases his forgiveness on himself and his forgiving character, not on the

you confess your sin, believing that God is exactly who he says he is. You confess while you give God all authority to interpret reality, instead of giving your personal feelings authority. Your feelings will say condemnation, but God says he doesn't treat you as your sins deserve. God must win in this interpretive battle."
