A BRIEF THOUGHT

An Excerpt from *Why We Love the Church*

Clearly, a growing number of Christians don’t like the church. The church doesn’t work for them anymore. And by their reasoning, if the church doesn’t work for you, then the best thing to do is just leave. The logic here is pretty simple. If by your estimation, church does not help you know God better, then you stop going to church. But what if belonging to a church is more serious than, say, choosing whether the new laundry detergent is “right for you”? What if your difficulty with church was God’s way of sanctifying you and the church, instead of separating the two of you? What if we aren’t always the best judge of what will help us most in living like Jesus? What if we need something to guide us that is more sophisticated, more sure, and less subjective than our own “freedom filters”? And what makes us think that after nearly 2,000 years of institutional church, Christians are suddenly free to jettison the church and try things on their own?
