REGISTRATION:

TRANSPORTATION:

PAYMENT:

The cost includes transportation, lodging, meals, activities, and a t-shirt/sweatshirt. *A non-refundable deposit of \$75 is due upon registration.* The remaining balance of \$80 is due by **October 28th**. BRING:
