A BRIEF THOUGHT

An Excerpt from *Evangelism* by J. Mack Stiles

To me, there is no better instruction for how we speak about Jesus than Paul’s illustration of being ambassadors in 2 Corinthians 5:20-21. Paul calls us to remember the power behind the message: Christ himself. We are told of our astounding responsibility to be representatives of the kingdom of God. We are Christ’s ambassadors. We are called to see people differently—to give up the human and worldly vision of others and to know and love them, understanding that they are lost sinners who need to be reconciled to God.

We must get the message right. After all, ambassadors don’t have the freedom to change the message; their job is to deliver it accurately. Likewise, we must not add or subtract from Christ’s message. We must correctly deliver the message so that sinners can be reconciled with the holy God, the Creator, who owns us and all those around us. Despite the fact that our sin is evil before him, he made a way of salvation by making him who knew no sin to be sin (taking on our sin) and to receive the just punishment of God on our behalf on the cross. This was so that in Jesus we might become the righteousness of God. This is the message we have been given to deliver.
